Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural program (Dance and Music Program) in the Sri Eallai Pitariyamman Temple situated at No.1/45, Martiyamman Kovil Street, Nayanoor, Kandachipuram Taluk, Villupuram District scheduled to be held on 22.04.2018 from 6.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m..

ORDER

The petitioner seeks a direction to the respondent to grant permission to conduct the cultural programme in Sri Eallai Pitariyamman Temple Festival, at No.1/45, Martiyamman Kovil Street, Nayanoor, Kandachipuram Taluk, Villupuram District on 22.4.2018, by considering his representation dated 16.04.2018.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is a resident of Nayanoor and also claims to be the one of the Dharmakarthas of the temple. Since the committee has been conducting the cultural programmes as a part of temple festival every year in a peaceful manner without any untoward incident in the past, he has submitted a representation to the respondent on 16.04.2018 seeking permission to conduct the cultural programme on 22.04.2018. As the said representation has not been considered by the respondent so far, the petitioner is before this Court.

3. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent, on instructions, would submit that the permission sought for by the petitioner may be granted with appropriate stringent conditions for maintaining law and order and also to avoid any untoward incident during the performance of such programme.

4. In view of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate for the respondent, this writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

(a) The cultural programme in connection with Sri Eallai Pitariyamman Temple Festival at No.1/45, Martiyamman Kovil Street, Nayanoor, Kandachipuram Taluk, Villupuram District be held on 22.04.2018 between 06.00 p.m., and 11.00 p.m.

(b) There should not be any kind of obscene dance or vulgar dialogues during the performance, by anyone of the participants.

(c) Double meaning songs should not be played so as to spoil the minds of students and the youths.

(d) No dance or songs, touching upon any political party or religion, community or caste be played.

(e) No flex boards in support of any political party or communal leader, shall be erected at the premises of the programme.

(f) The function should not affect either religious or communal harmony and shall be conducted without any discrimination based on caste.

(g) If there is any violation of any one of the conditions imposed, the concerned Police Officer is at liberty to take necessary action, as per law and stop such performance forthwith.

(h) Similarly, the Police is directed to stop the dance programme, if it is played beyond the permitted time limit, and

(i) The respondent is directed to issue necessary permission incorporating the above conditions.

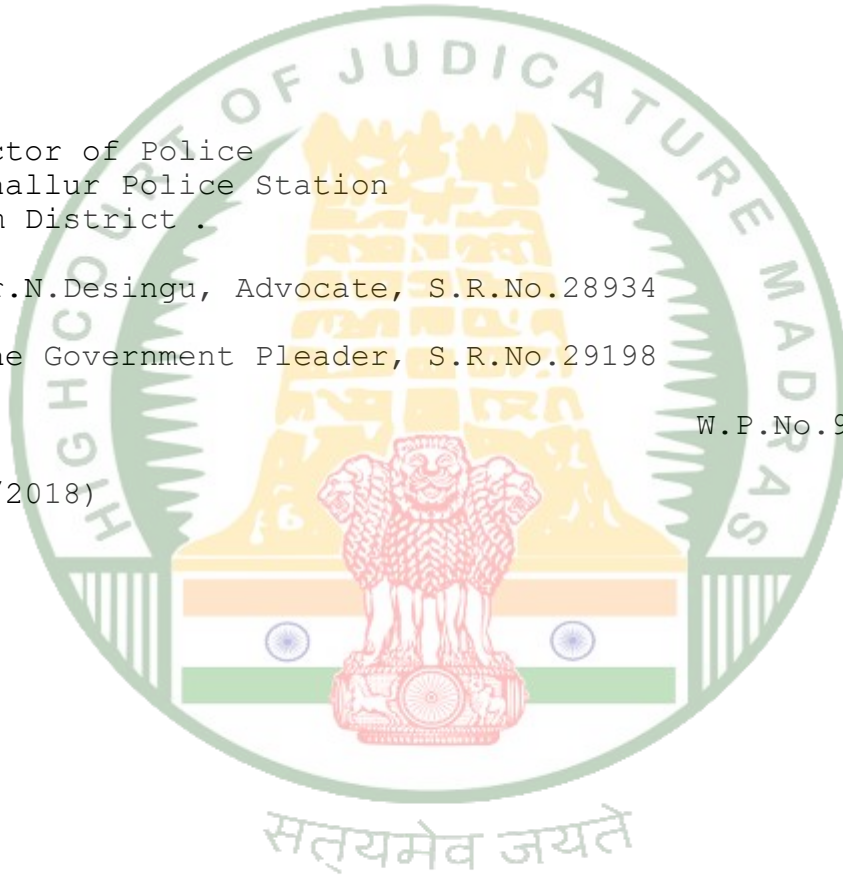
