Accordingly, these writ petitions are disposed of, only by directing the second respondent to consider the representations made by the petitioners dated 16.02.2018 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the petitioners as well as the rival claimants and other interested parties, if any. Such exercise shall be done by the second respondent within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
