Mr.D.Suriyanarayanan, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents. By consent of the parties, the main writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The petitioner seeks for a mandamus directing the first respondent to consider and pass orders on his representation dated 15.04.2015, wherein and whereby, he sought for regularising the purchase of two plots, by the petitioner under

the Innocent Buyers Category, by placing reliance on the order passed by the Government in G.O.No.565 Revenue Department dated 26.09.2008.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The grievance of the petitioner is that the said representation has not been considered so far.

5. Needless to say that it is for the first respondent to consider the said request of the petitioner and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, also by taking note of the above said G.O. relied on by the petitioner, provided the said G.O. is applicable to the case of the petitioner in all four corners. Such exercise shall be done by the first respondent within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
