Today, a Joint Memo of Compromise, dated 06.03.2018 and an Affidavit, dated 06.03.2018 was also filed by the 2nd respondent/defacto complainant to the effect that he has no objection to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.173 of 2015, pending on the file of the Learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Sriperumpudur, Kancheepuram.

5. Recording the same, the proceedings in C.C.No.173 of 2015, pending on the file of the Learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Sriperumpudur, Kancheepuram is quashed. The Criminal Original Petition is allowed.
