2.According to the petitioner, she made a representation to the respondents requesting them to make a survey and she had

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he had one Paripooranam has encroached upon the plot allotted to the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made, without going into the merits of the case, this Court directs the second respondent to pass orders on the representation of the petitioner, on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the petitioner and also affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
