weeks.

petitioner alleging non-compliance of the order dated
27.02.2016 passed by this Court.

3.Today, when the matter is taken up, the learned
Special Government Pleader (HR & CE) appearing for the
respondent submitted that the order passed by this Court
has been duly complied with by the respondents.

with, nothing survives in this contempt petition and
accordingly, the same is closed.
