ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by S.M. SUBRAMANIAM, J.)

The relief sought for in this Habeas Corpus Petition is for a direction to direct the first and second respondents to produce the detenu Ms.Subha, D/o.Nagaraj, aged about 23 years, before this Court and set her at liberty.

2.The learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2 now submitted a proceedings of the Judicial Magistrate at Sirkali stating the detainee had been produced before the learned Judicial Magistrate at Sirkali by Anaikkaran Chathiram Police Station with reference to Crime No.49/2018. The detainee Ms.Subha deposed before the learned

Judicial Magistrate that she got married with one Mr.Sathishkumar and she is living with him. In this regard, the certificate of registration of marriage, registered in Sl.No.137/2018, dated 02.02.2018 has also been produced before us.

3.In view of the fact that the detenue is not illegally detained, and further she got married with one Mr.Sathishkumar and leading a matrimonial home. Thus, there is no ground for entertaining this Habeas Corpus Petition.

4.Accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
