This being the factum informed by the Detenu, no further adjudication needs to be undertaken in this habeas corpus petition. Accordingly, the same stands closed.

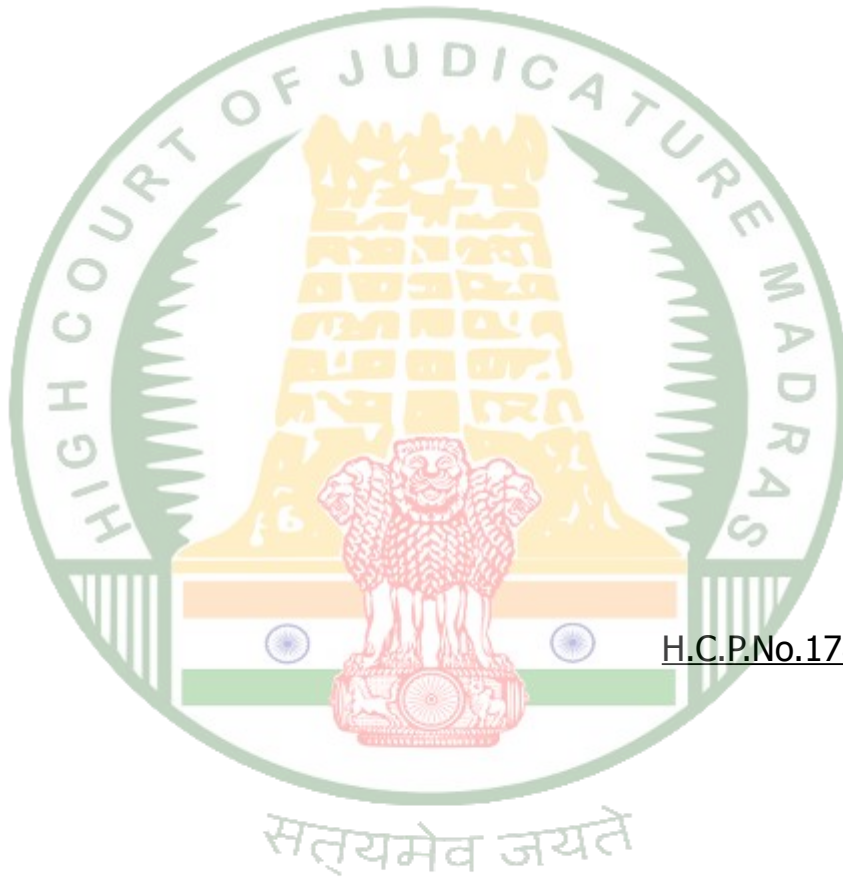
