O R D E R

The present writ petition has been filed challenging the order passed by Tahsildar in proceeding dated 11.07.2013 in respect of the property claimed by the writ petitioner.

5. Accordingly the writ petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to Costs. Consequently connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
