ORDER

This Court by order dated 09.03.2016 allowed the writ petition in W.P.No.26615 of 2015 forbearing the respondents from implementing the revised fee structure and stipend guidelines prescribed by the National Board of Examinations and adopted by the Railway Board as contained in the Letter of the Deputy Director (Health), Railway Board, dated 31.10.2014 and the consequent circular issued by the Additional Chief Health Director & DNB Coordinator, Southern Railway Head Quarters Hospital, dated 27.11.2014.
