2 Heard learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondents 1 and 2 and Mr.M.Radhakrishnan, learned counsel appearing for 3rd respondent.

3 It is brought to notice that detenue Anbarasi is no more and an enquiry u/s.174 Cr.P.C. is pending.

4 Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that according to the petitioner, the petitioner's wife has not committed suicide and she was subjected to homicidal violence [honour killing].

3 In the circumstances, this Habeas Corpus Petition shall stand closed.
