PRAYER

ORDER

3. The Civil Revision Petition is disposed of with above direction. No costs.

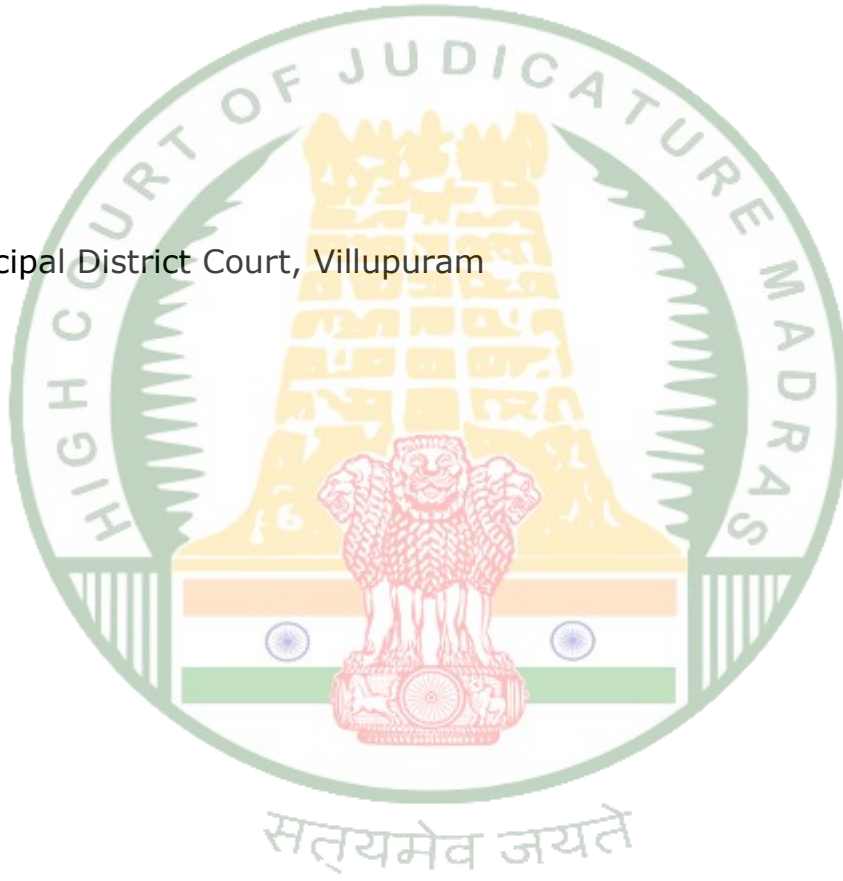
