According to the order passed by the learned Magistrate, the victim girl has been produced before him, on 02.07.2018.

4. Recording that there is no complaint against the Police and after going through the documents, the Court below has recorded the view that the victim girl is major and she is set at liberty. As nothing survives for adjudication, this Habeas Corpus petition is closed

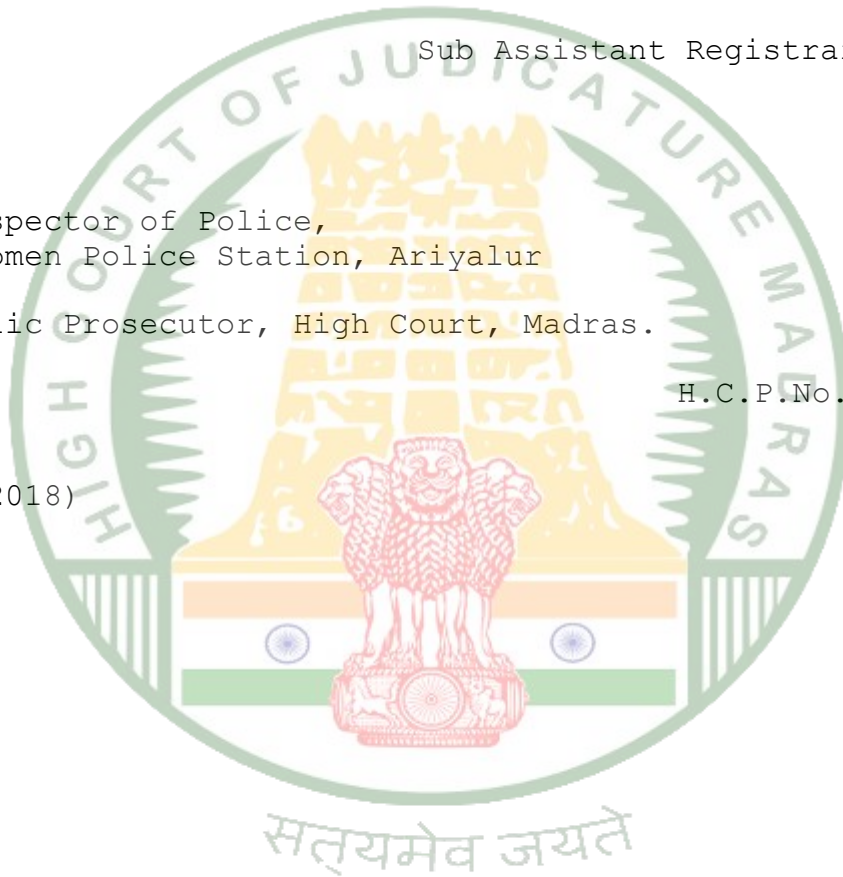
