O R D E R

3.Though the petitioner has sought for alteration of the FIR by inclusion of other offences, I am of the view that it is subject to the outcome of the investigation and as such, ends of justice would be secured if the respondent police is directed to file a final report. Accordingly, the respondent police is directed to complete the investigation in FIR No.266 of 2017 pending on his file and file a final report within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4.With the above observation and direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

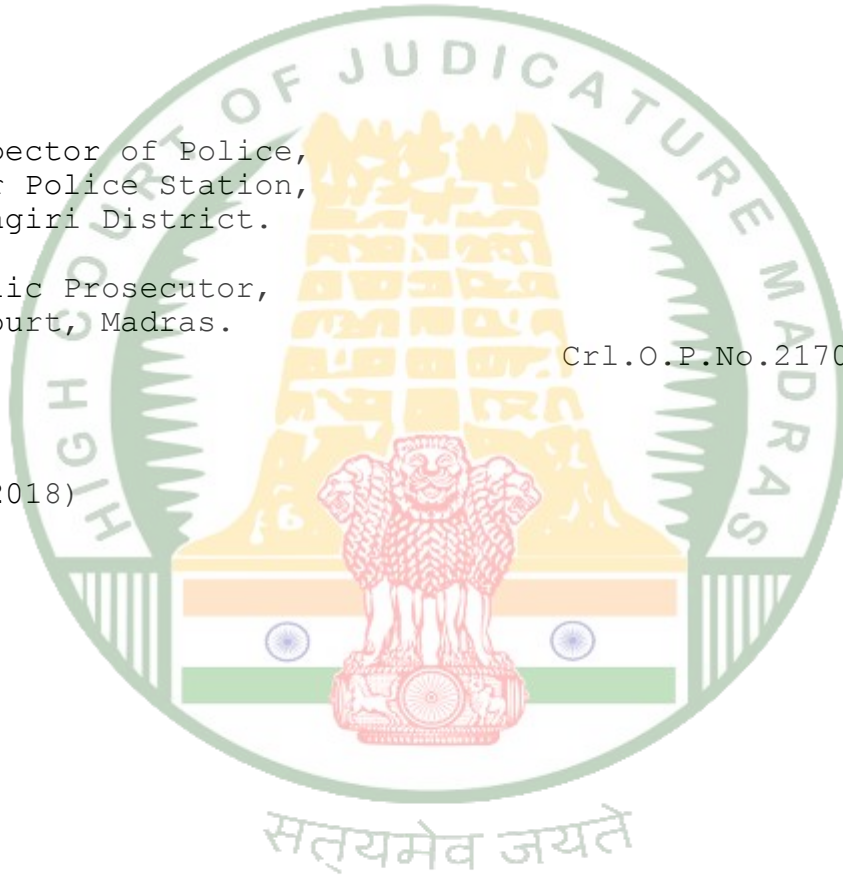
