ORDER

When the matter is taken up for hearing, it is represented by the learned Additional Government Pleader that the direction issued by this Court, vide its order dated 09.04.2018 has been complied with by the first respondent, by passing proceedings, dated 30.07.2018, rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

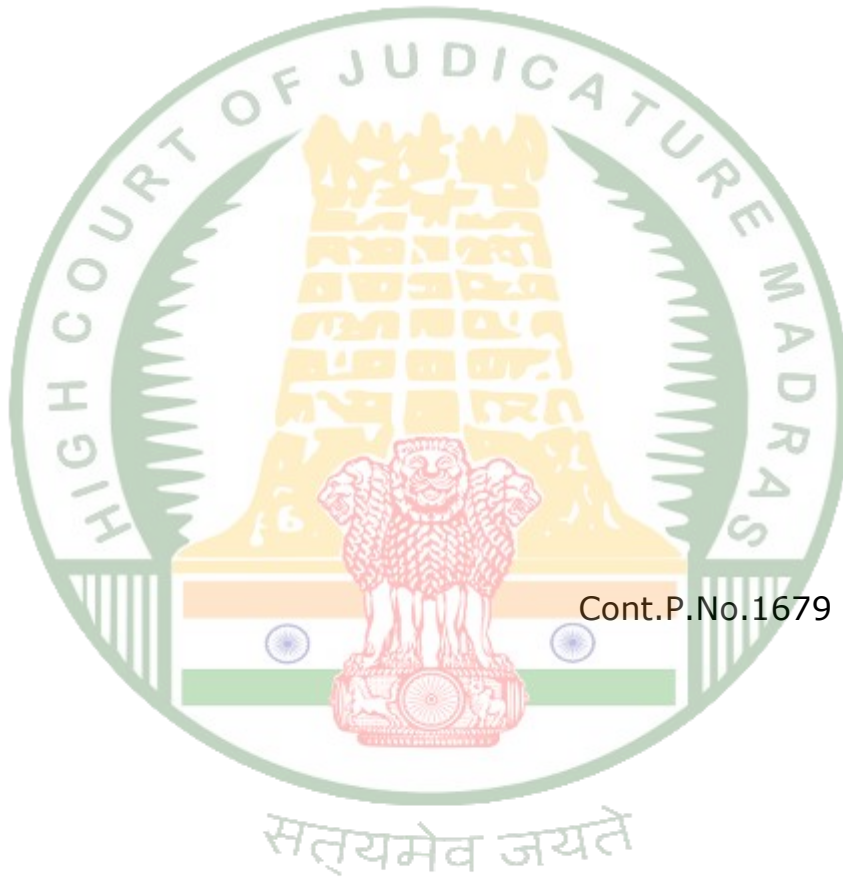
