TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

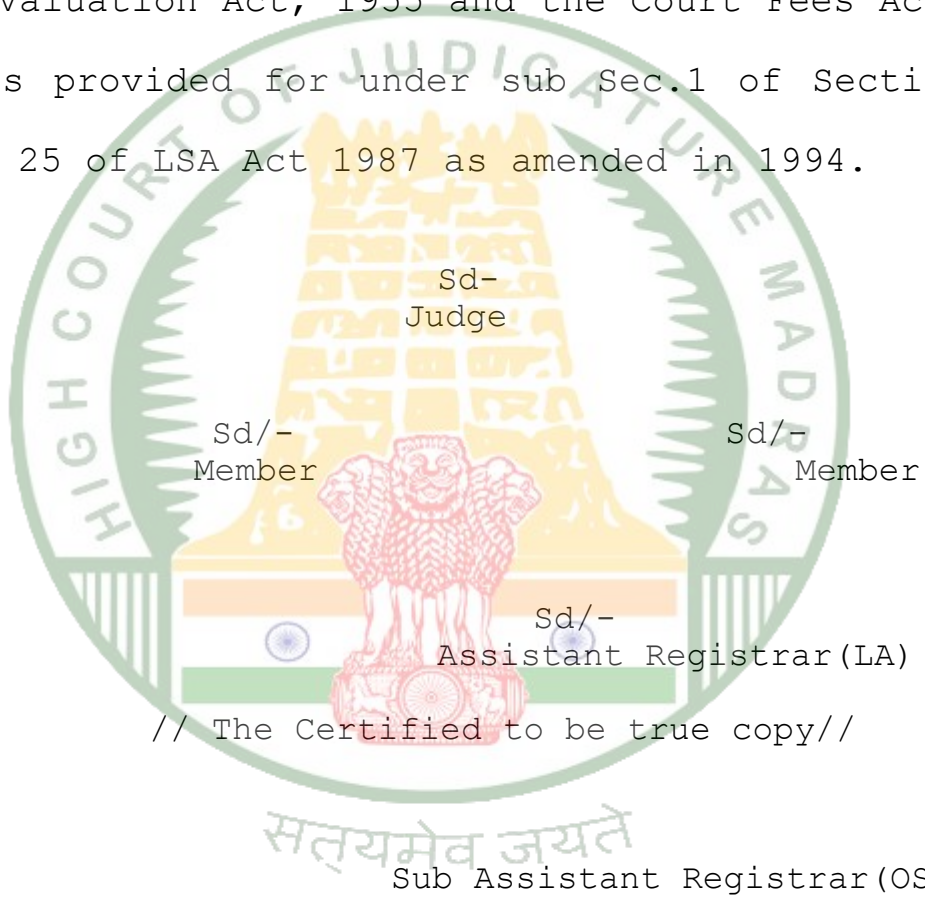
The plaintiff and his counsel are present. Defendant also present. The learned counsel for plaintiff has made an endorsement on the court bundle it reads as follows:-
