ORDER

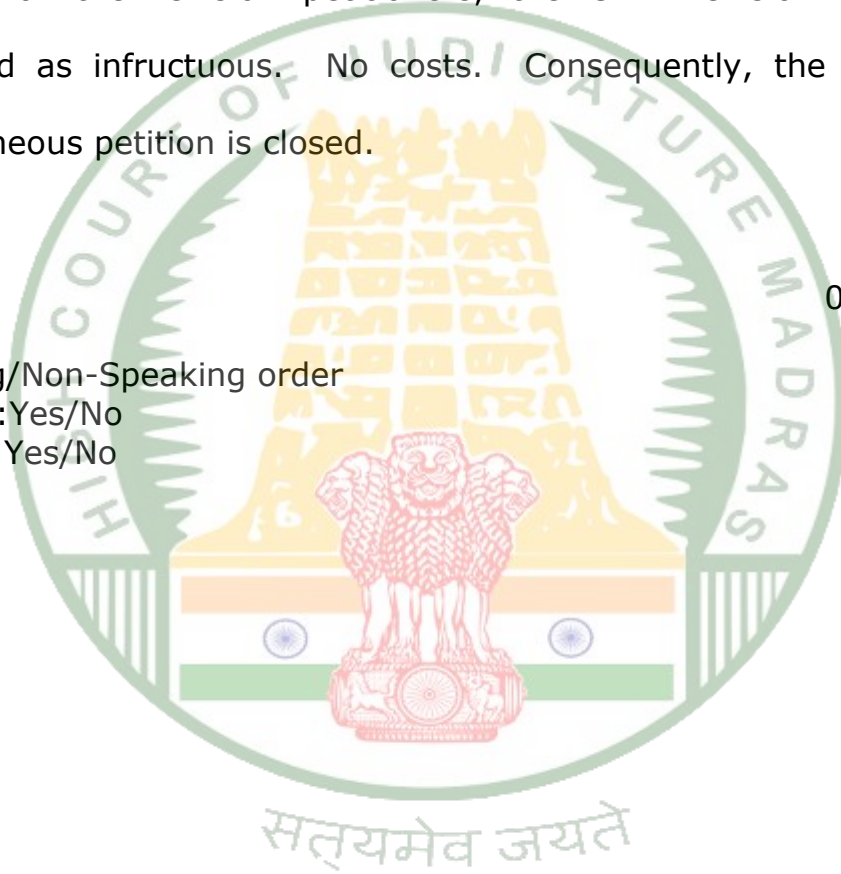
The learned counsel for the revision petitioners would submit that as nothing survives in the Civil Revision Petition, the same

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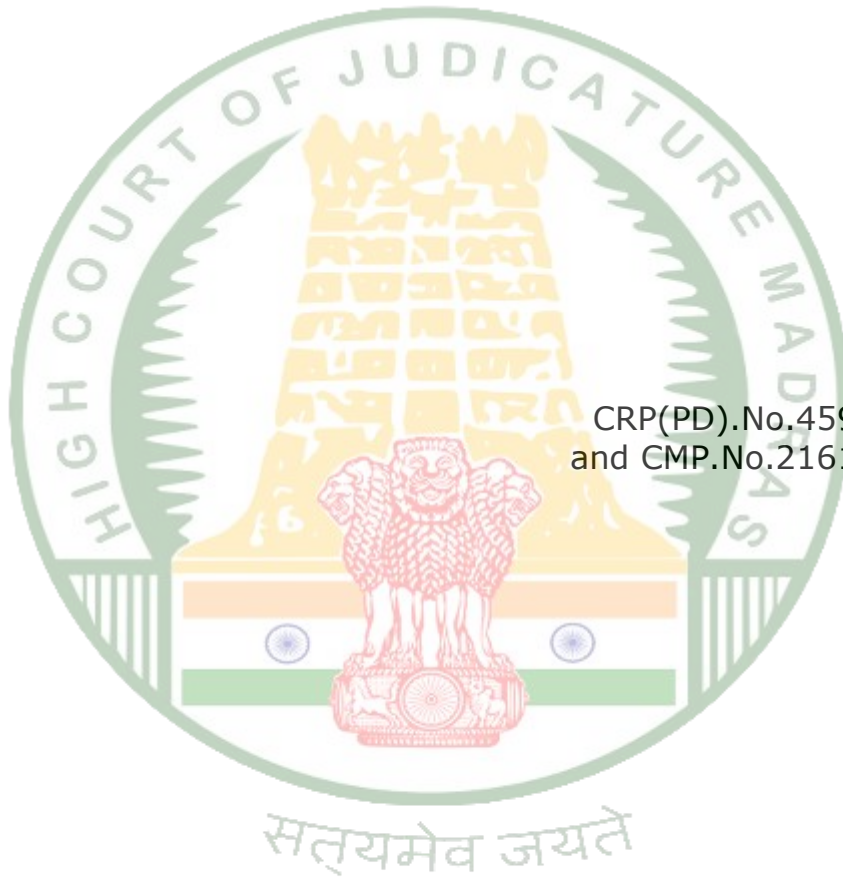
