ORDER

The petitioner, who is the cousin of the detainee herein, viz., P.Shruthi @ Mythili Venkatesh, Daughter of Prasanna Venkatesh, aged 21 years, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent

by his order in C.No.29/G/IS/2018, dated 02.03.2018 against his niece branding her as a "Goonda" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982].

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the niece of the petitioner herein dated 02.03.2018 has been revoked by the Government in G.O.Rt.No.1465, Home, Prohibition & Excise [XII] Department dated 16.04.2018 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
