petition filed by the revision petitioner, the respondent has not filed vakalat and the petition has been posted for filing counter affidavit. But the respondent has not chosen to file counter. Hence, the revision petitioner has filed the present Civil Revision Petitions before this Court for early disposal of the said HMOP's.

By considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the revision petitioner and taking into consideration that the petitions are of the year 2017 without expressing any opinion on merits, this Court is inclined to direct the Subordinate Court, Namakkal to dispose of the HMOP.Nos.7 & 20 of 2017 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible after providing an opportunity to the parties concerned.
