4. Since the order of this Court has been complied with, nothing survives in this contempt petition and accordingly, the same is closed.

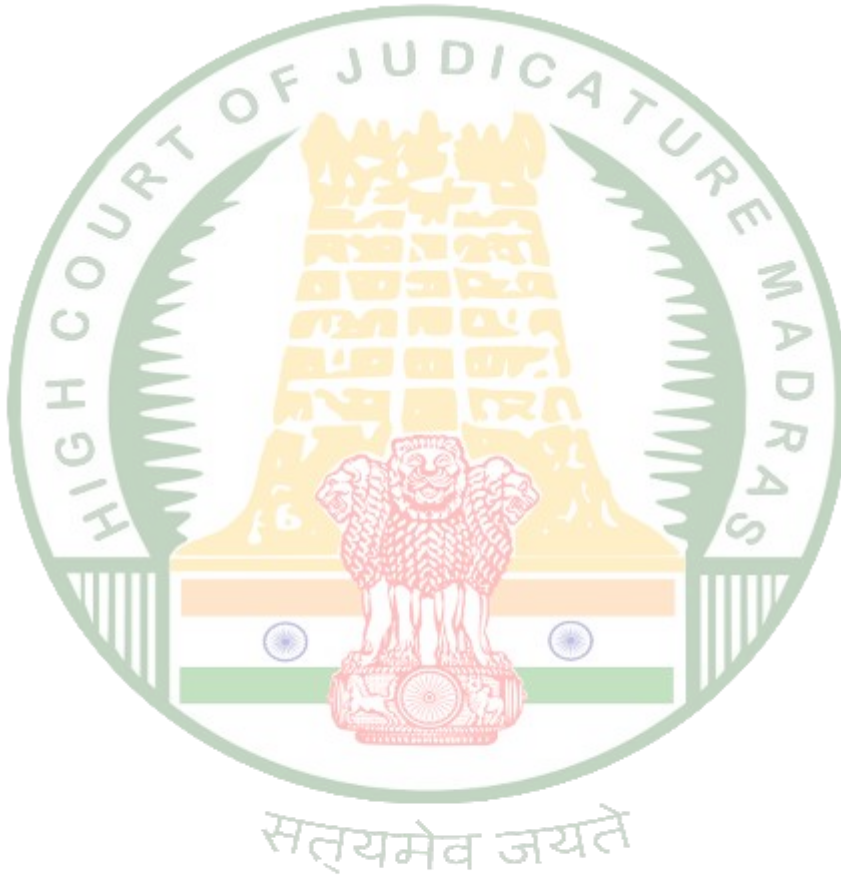
