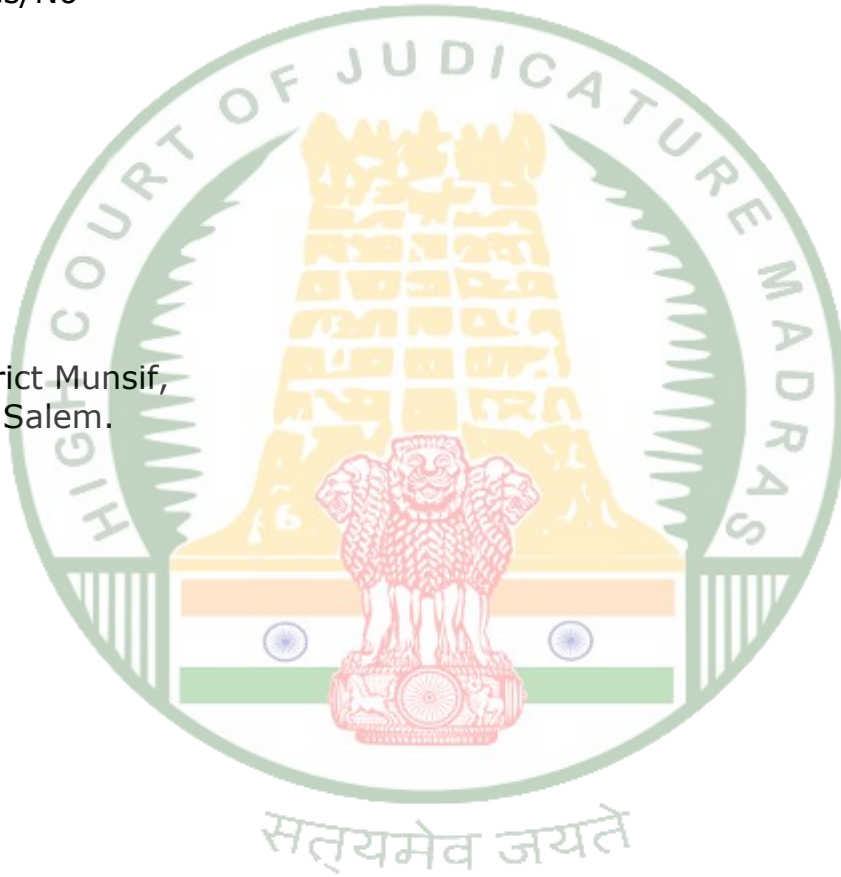
5. With the above direction, this Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

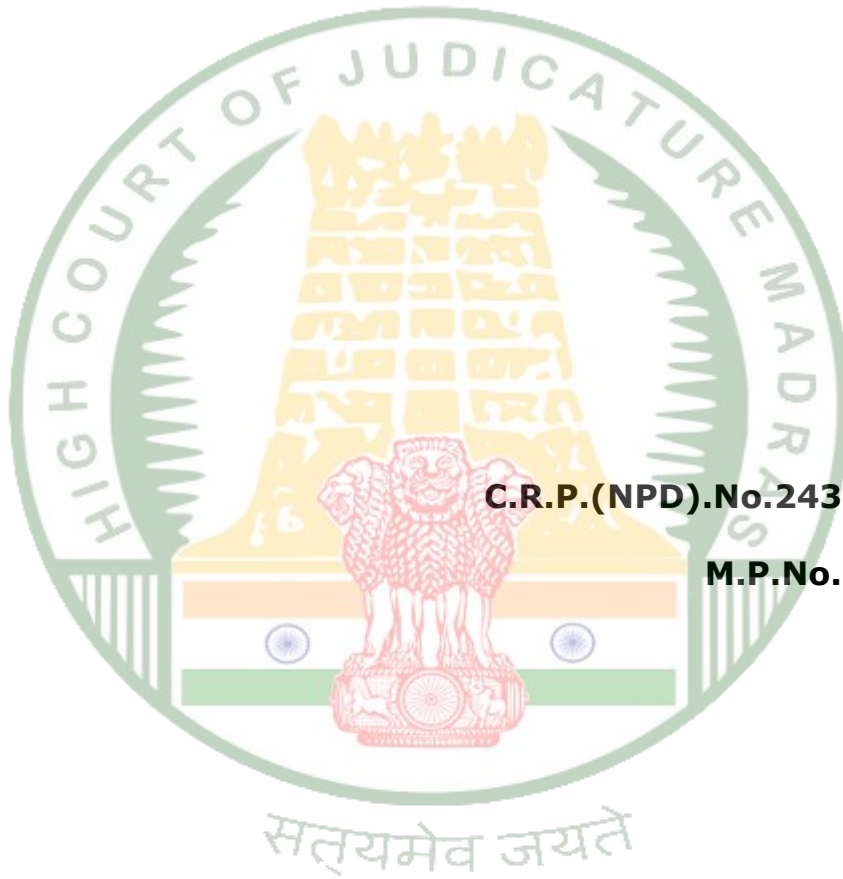
