PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, calling for the records of the detention made in Memo No.646/BCDFGISSSV/2018 dated 03.08.2018 passed by the Commissioner of Police, Greater Chennai Police, Vepery, Chennai - 7 the second respondent herein and set aside the same and direct the respondents to produce the detenu before this Hon'ble Court and set the detenu Thiru.Puliankottai @ Elango, Son of Poosalingam, aged 43 years now confined in Central Prison, Puzhal-II, Chennai at liberty.

The petitioner, who is the son of the detenu herein, viz., Puliankottai @ Elango, son of Poosalingam, aged 43 years, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent by his order in No.646/BCDFGISSSV/2018, dated 03.08.2018 against his father branding him as a "GOONDA" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of

Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982].

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the father of the petitioner herein dated 03.08.2018 has been revoked by the Government in G.O.Rt.No.4147, Home, Prohibition & Excise [XIII] Department dated 28.09.2018 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
