It is represented on behalf of the Respondents 1 and 2 that in G.O.Rt.No.127, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIII) Department, dated 12.01.2018, the detention of the petitioner's husband was revoked by the competent authority.

2. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner has also made an endorsement inter alia to the effect that the petitioner is not pressing the present Habeas Corpus Petition because of the fact that the detention order was revoked.

3. Recording the aforesaid facts and the endorsement so made, the present Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
