O R D E R

The writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents 1 to 5 to take legal action to discontinue the functioning of the 6th respondent school and also to direct the 6th respondent to return the fees amount collected from him with compensation by considering his representation dated 05.05.2017.

2.When the matter was taken up for consideration, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 05.05.2017 pointing out certain irregularities made by the management of the sixth respondent school and the said representation has not been considered so far by either of the respondents 1 to 5.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the respective parties and perused the materials placed before this Court.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents 1 to 5 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 05.05.2017 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, after giving due opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner as well as the sixth respondent school, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.
