ORDER

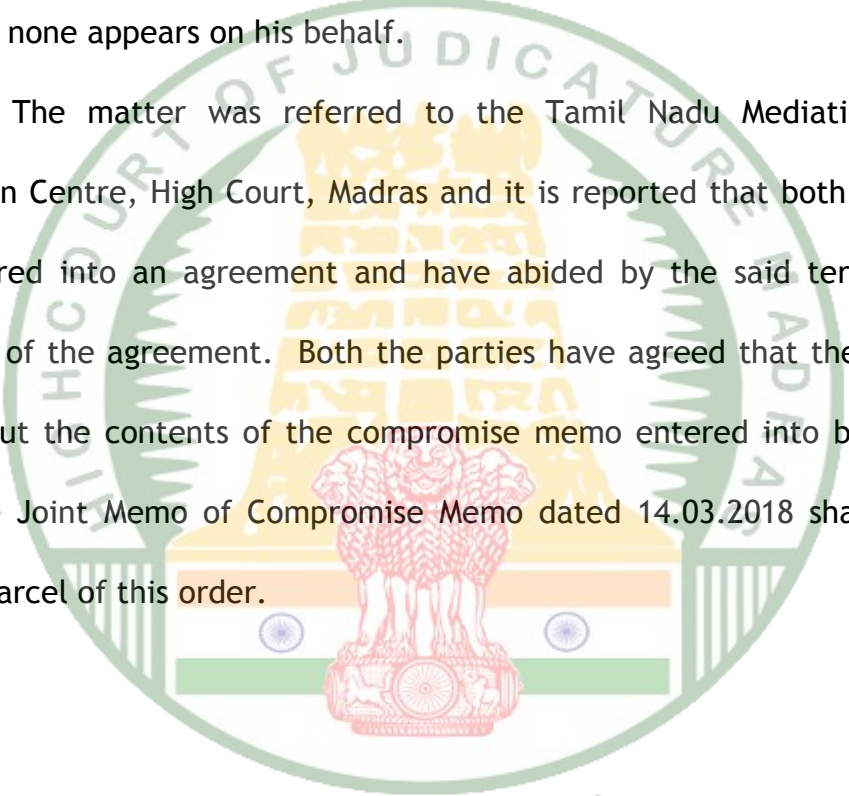

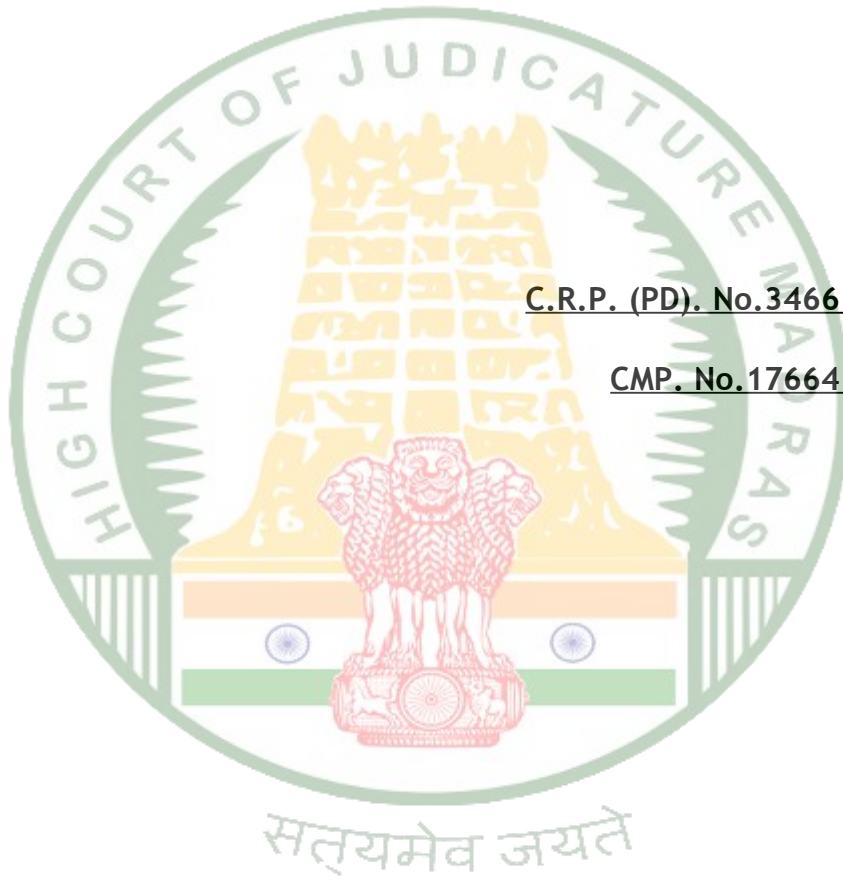
