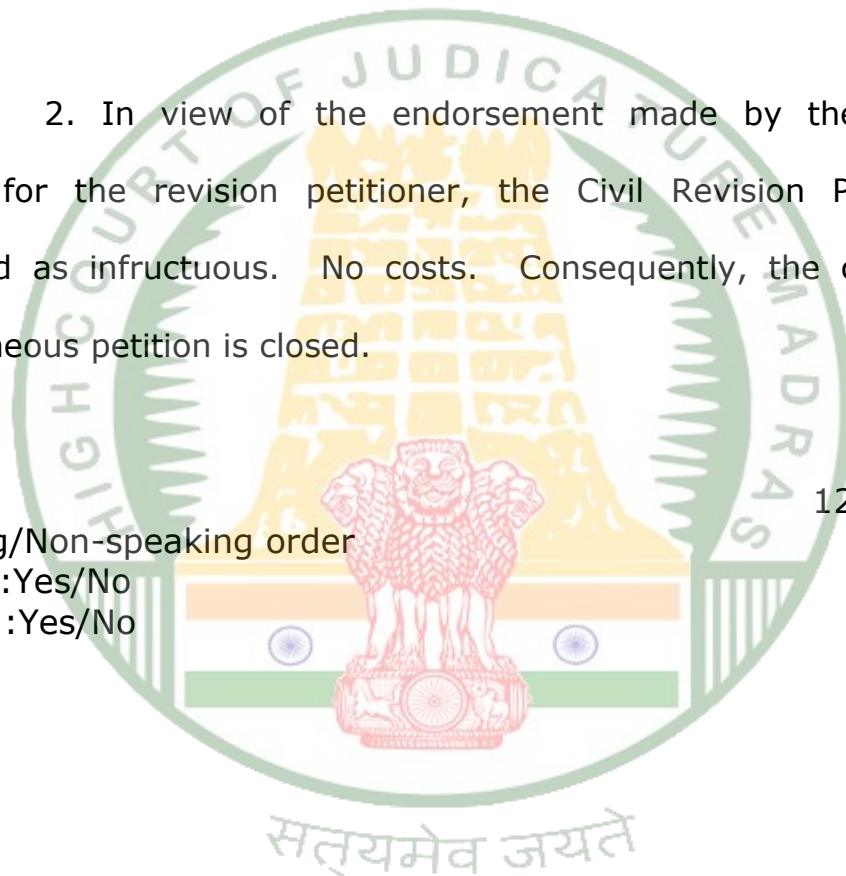
ORDER

The learned counsel for the revision petitioner would submit that as nothing survives in the Civil Revision Petition, the same has become infructuous. He has also made an endorsement to that effect.

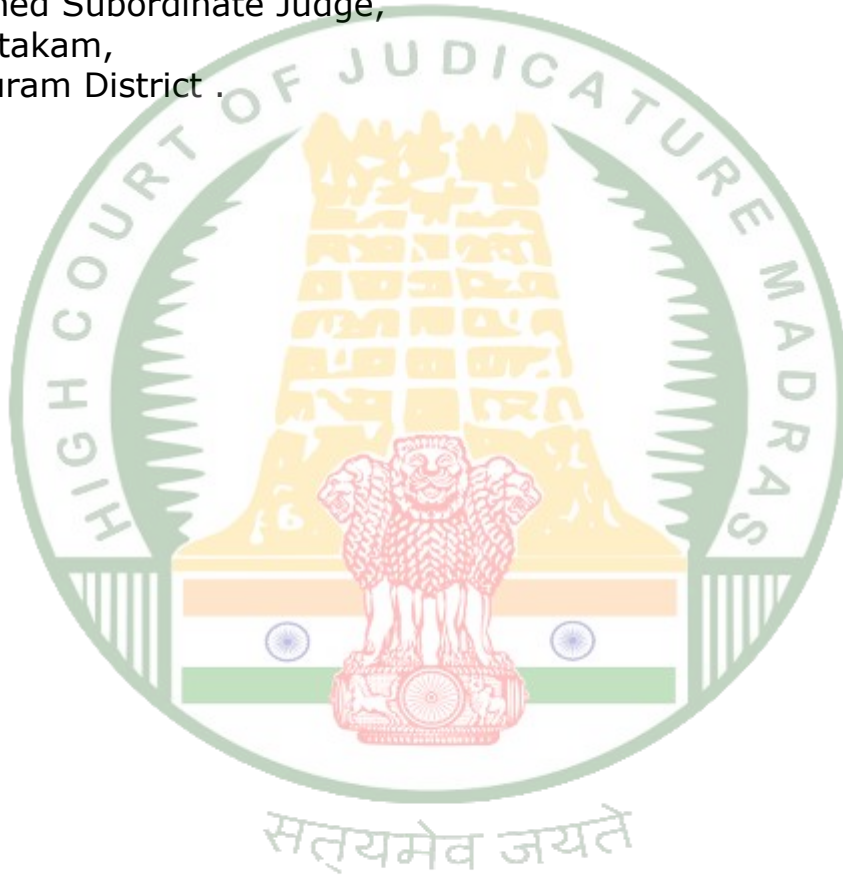

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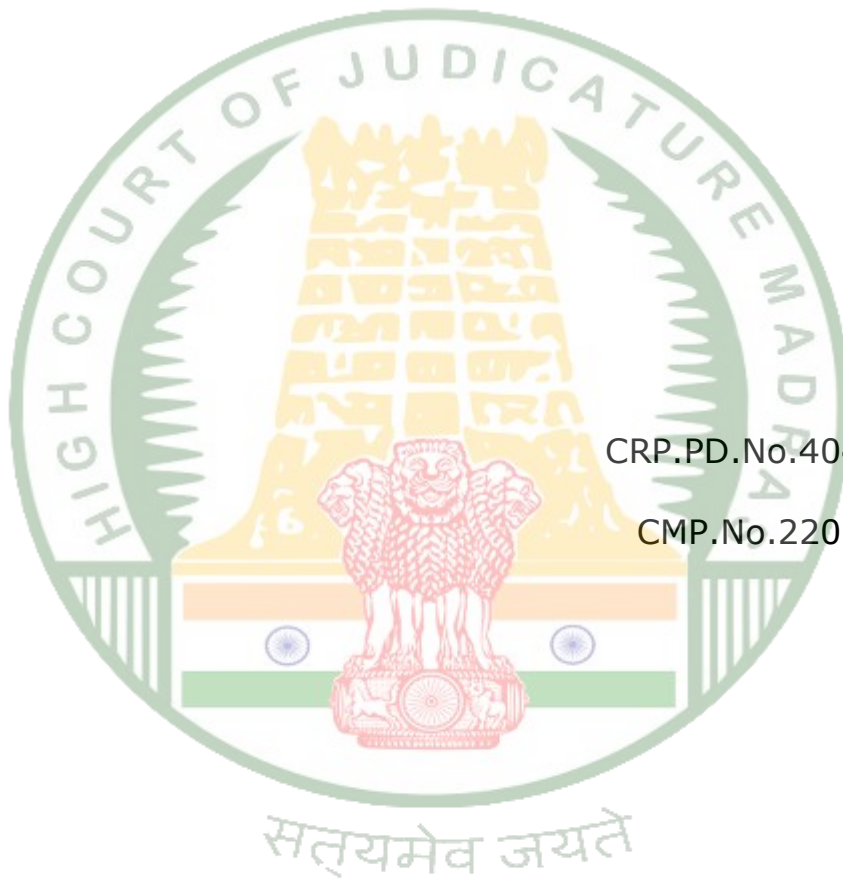
