Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 03.05.2018 and to direct the respondent to measure the property of the petitioner situated at Padiyanallur Village, Tiruvallur District, Ponneri Taluk, in survey No.88/13C2A, measuring to an extent of 1615 sq.ft. to survey the land and also to earmark the boundaries by laying the stone in the petitioner's property.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondent to consider his representation dated 03.05.2018 and to measure his property situated at Padiyanallur Village, Tiruvallur District, Ponneri Taluk, in Survey No.88/13C2A, measuring to an extent of 1615 sq.ft. and also to earmark the boundaries by laying the stone.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 03.05.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but,

the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.J.Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondent, submitted that the respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 03.05.2018 on payment of necessary charges and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
