The petitioners seek for a mandamus directing the respondents 1 & 2 to provide electricity service connection to the petitioners residential premises.

3. All these petitioners are admittedly tenants under the 3rd respondent. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 submitted that since there was an objection raised by the 3rd respondent, these respondents were not in a position to provide electricity connection to the petitioners premises. 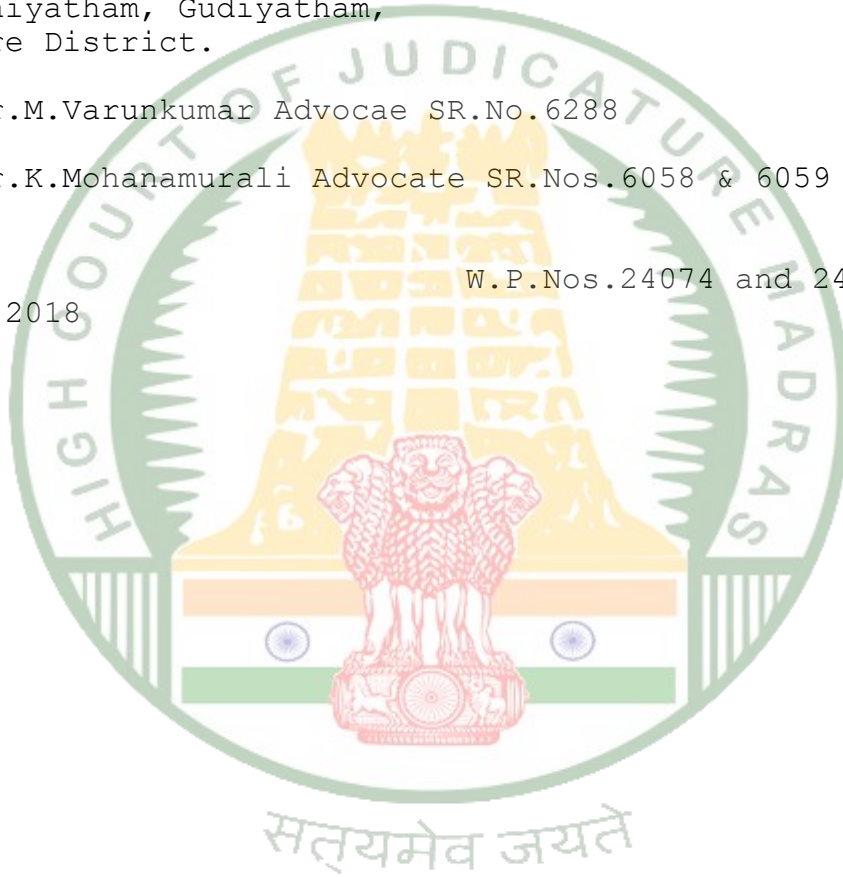
