PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to consider the application of legal heir certificate submitted by the petitioner to the respondent dated 20.07.2018 and consequential relief directing the respondent to issue legal heir certificate in favour of the petitioner.

O R D E R

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondent to consider the application for legal heir certificate submitted by the petitioner to the respondent dated 20.07.2018 and to issue legal heir certificate in favour of the petitioner.

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation claiming the same relief as mentioned above, but, the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the respondent. However, the learned counsel submitted that it would suffice, if the representation dated 20.07.2018 made by the petitioner is directed to be considered by the respondent, on merits.

4. Mr.J.Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondent, submitted that the respondent may be directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 20.07.2018 and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and also taking into consideration the limited prayer sought for in the writ petition, this Court directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 20.07.2018 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
