Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to pass orders on the revision petition dated 10.07.2018 which was preferred challenging the order passed by the second respondent in Proceeding Na.Ka.32376/2016/U2 dated 21.11.2017 confirming the order passed by the third respondent in Na.Ka.7594/2016/A3 dated 03.02.2017.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the first respondent to pass orders on the revision petition dated 10.07.2018 preferred by him challenging the order passed by the second respondent in Proceeding Na.Ka.32376/2016/U2 dated 21.11.2017 confirming the order passed by the third respondent in Na.Ka.7594/2016/A3 dated 03.02.2017.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has preferred a Revision Petition dated 10.07.2018 claiming issuance of patta, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the first respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mrs.P.Rajalakshmi, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the first respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's Revision Petition and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's Revision Petition dated 10.07.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
