3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.Side) appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner is complying with the conditions regularly imposed by this Court for the past 18 days.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition already imposed on the petitioner is relaxed. However, the

petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation on receipt of summons. This petition is ordered accordingly.
