Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 09.06.2017 and cancel the patta issued in the name of Veerammal in respect of property namely S.No.65/5 of T.Mottur Village, T.Velur Panchayat, Thandrapattu Taluk, Tiruvannamalai District to an extent of 1 Acres 14 cents and issue patta in the name of the petitioner pertaining to the above property.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to consider her representation dated 09.06.2017 and cancel the patta issued in the name of Veerammal in respect of property, namely, S.No.65/5 of T.Mottur Village, T.Velur Panchayat, Thandrapattu Taluk, Tiruvannamalai District to an extent of 1 Acres 14 cents and issue patta in her name pertaining to the above property.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation

dated 09.06.2017, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.V.Shanmugasundar, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the second respondent be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 09.06.2017 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
