Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, to forbear the third respondent from altering the service conditions of the members of petitioner union as stated in the accompanying members list including discontinuance of their services or any act including implementation of Lay-Off, retrenchment which will result in temporary/permanent non-employment of them, without getting prior permission from the second respondent in terms of Section 33 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 in the industrial disputes raised by the petitioner union viz., Aa/873/2016, Aa/911/2016 & Aa/403/2017 pending on the file of the second respondent and further direct the second respondent to conciliate and effect settlement under Section 12(3) and if no settlement is forthcoming to submit failure report under section 12(4) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 to the first respondent and in turn the first respondent to refer the dispute for adjudication before the competent industrial adjudicator.
