The petitioner filed this petition for relaxing the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.20771 of 2018 for the offence punishable under Section 7 and 13(2) read with 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 in Crime No.16 of 2018 while granting bail to the petitioner.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.Side) appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner has complied with the condition only for 8 days and that the investigation is in the midway and hence, this petition may be dismissed.

4. In view of the submissions made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor (crl.side), this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed. However, this Order shall not stand in the way of the petitioner complying the condition imposed by this Court.
