Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records relating to the orders passed by the third respondent in proceedings Nil dated 09/01/2018 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to reimburse the petitioner a sum of Rs.1,35,000/- (Rupees One Lakh thirtyfive thousand only) with interest at 9% p.a. On receipt of the documents from the Writ Petitioner, the Third Respondent is directed to consider the same in accordance with the Scheme and pass orders within four weeks, thereafter. In view of the undertaking given, the order impugned need not be implemented.

3.Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. However, there is no order as to costs.
