2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to change the Revenue Records in her favour in respect of the property in S.No.68/3B measuring to an extent of 2.18 Acres situated at Kottagoundampatti Village, Omalur Taluk, by considering her representation dated 14.06.2018.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 14.06.2018

claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.V.Shanmuga Sundar, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 14.06.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
