Writ Petition in W.P.No.7331 of 2012, is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondent to re-auction the right to collect the parking charges for the parking area situated at newly constructed old bus stand complex, Tiruppur notified as Item No.31 of Notification dated 06.03.2012 in File No.350/2012/A11 on the file of the first respondent.

Writ Petition in W.P.No.9458 of 2012, is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to Resolution No.406 dated 28.03.2012 on the file of the 1st respondent and quash the same and direct the 1st and 2nd respondent herein to re-auction the right to collect the parking charges for the parking area situated at newly constructed old bus stand complex, Tiruppur notified as Item No.31 of Notification Gazetted in January 2012 in File No.350/2012/A11 on the file of the second respondent after publishing the terms and conditions of the auction in clear and transparent manner.

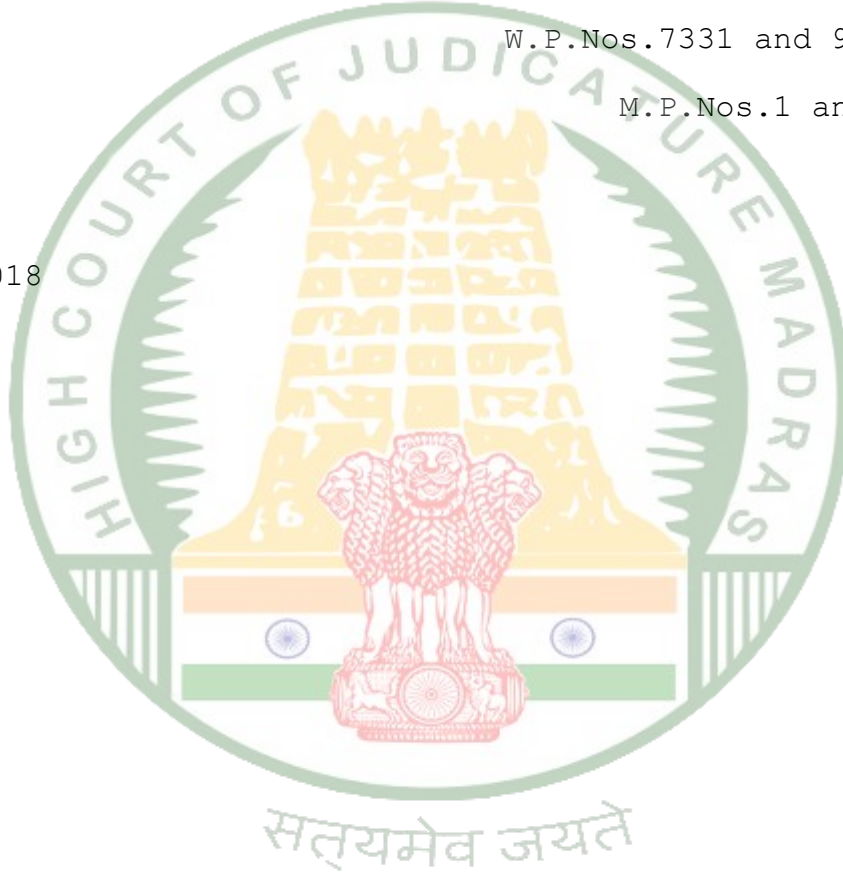
