ORDER

2.On the complaint lodged by the petitioner that there was theft in her house, the respondent police have registered a case in Crime No.1008 of 2017 on 19.09.2017 for the offences under Sections 457 and 380 of IPC against unknown accused.

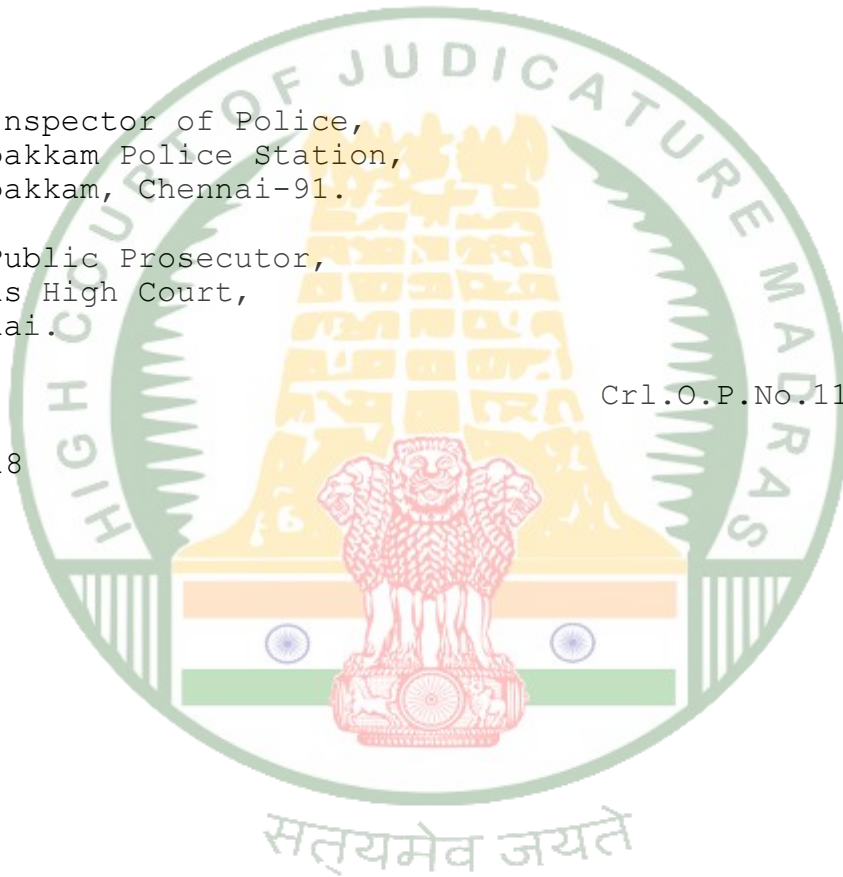
