(ORDER OF THE COURT WAS MADE BY N.KIRUBAKARAN, J.)

When the matter came up for hearing on 05.06.2018, there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was directed to be listed after one week. Again when the matter came up for hearing on 12.06.2018, there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner and this Court directed the Registry to print the name of the petitioner along with the name of the learned counsel for the petitioner with address and the matter was directed to be listed on 19.06.2018. 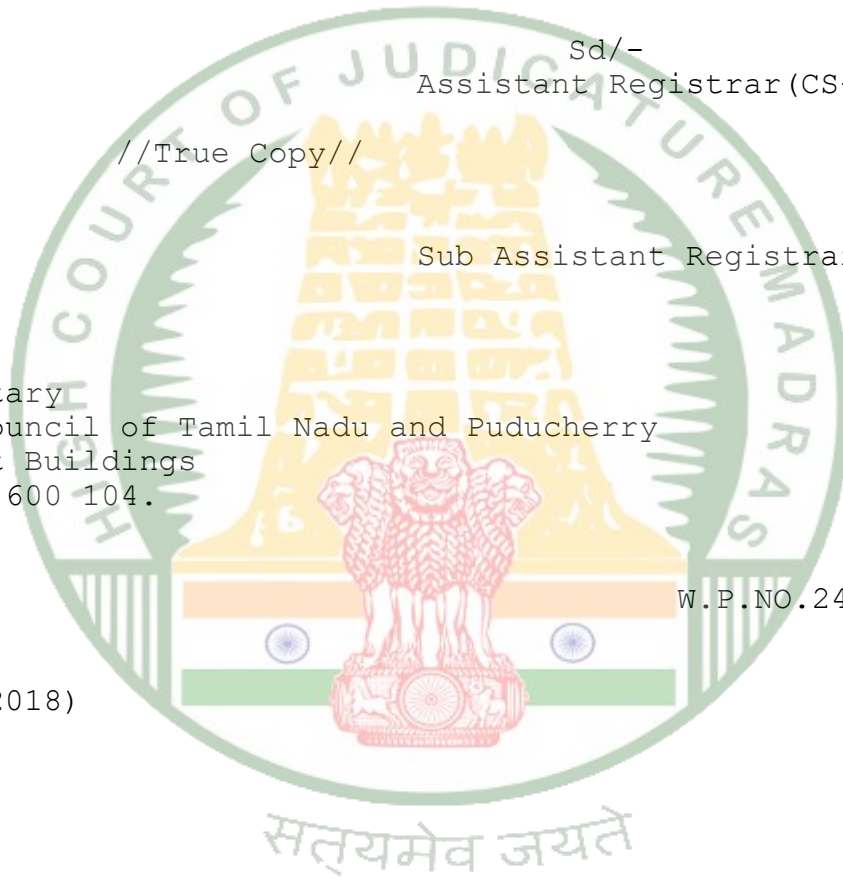
