ORDER

By consent of both parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the first respondent to conduct independent and impartial enquiry on his representation dated 07.09.2018 by rejecting the application of the respondents 5 and 6 dated Nil for inclusion of their name in patta for S.F.No.51/7A mentioned in Na.Ka.3853/2018/A2.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 07.09.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the said representation is yet to be disposed of by the respondents 1 to 3. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.V.Shanmuga Sundar, learned Special Government Pleader taking notice for the respondents 1 to 3, submitted that the respondents 1 to 3 be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the respondents 1 to 3 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 07.09.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, respondents 4 to 6 as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. Consequently, connected W.M.P. is closed. No costs.
