Prayer:Writ petitions filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to forthwith receive the tender schedules of the petitioner with regard to the works pursuant to tender Notice Nos.3/2018-2019/SDO dated 13.04.2018 and 4/2018-2019/SDO dated 16.04.2018 respectively.

The last date for submission of tender is 24.05.2018 and pre-qualification documents will be opened at 3.15 p.m. on the same day. The petitioner, who is interested to participate in the work had drawn Demand Drafts towards bid security and went to the office of the second respondent to submit the tender documents. However, the 2nd respondent refused to receive the tender schedules. Hence, the present writ petitions.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing, this Court directed the learned Special Government Pleader to get instructions regarding submission of tender schedules. On instructions, the learned Special Government Pleader would submit that the petitioner can submit his tender schedules before the second respondent today before 3.00 p.m. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner appeared before the second respondent, who had also accepted the tender schedules.

4. In view of the same, nothing survives for adjudication in the writ petitions. Accordingly, the writ petitions are closed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
