He has also made an endorsement to that effect in the Court bundle.

3.In view of the above said submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, nothing survives for further adjudication in this case. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition shall stand dismissed as infructuous.

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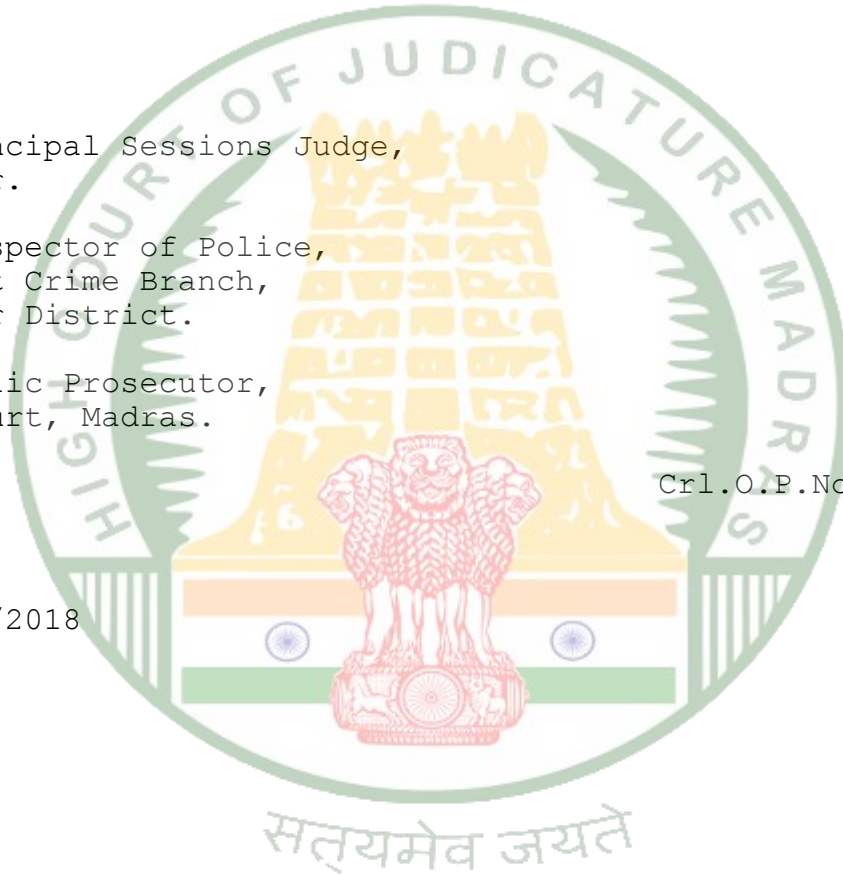
