3. The learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondents, made a submission that the Government issued a common order in G.O.Ms.No.64, School Education Department dated 03.04.2018, for grant of approval, in respect of the Non-Teaching staff appointed in Aided School.

4. In view of the common order passed by the Government, the case of the writ petitioner also to be considered. It is further informed that the appointment of the writ petitioner has already been approved. Therefore, there is no further adjudication needs to be undertaken, in respect of the grounds raised in this writ petition.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition stands closed. However, there shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

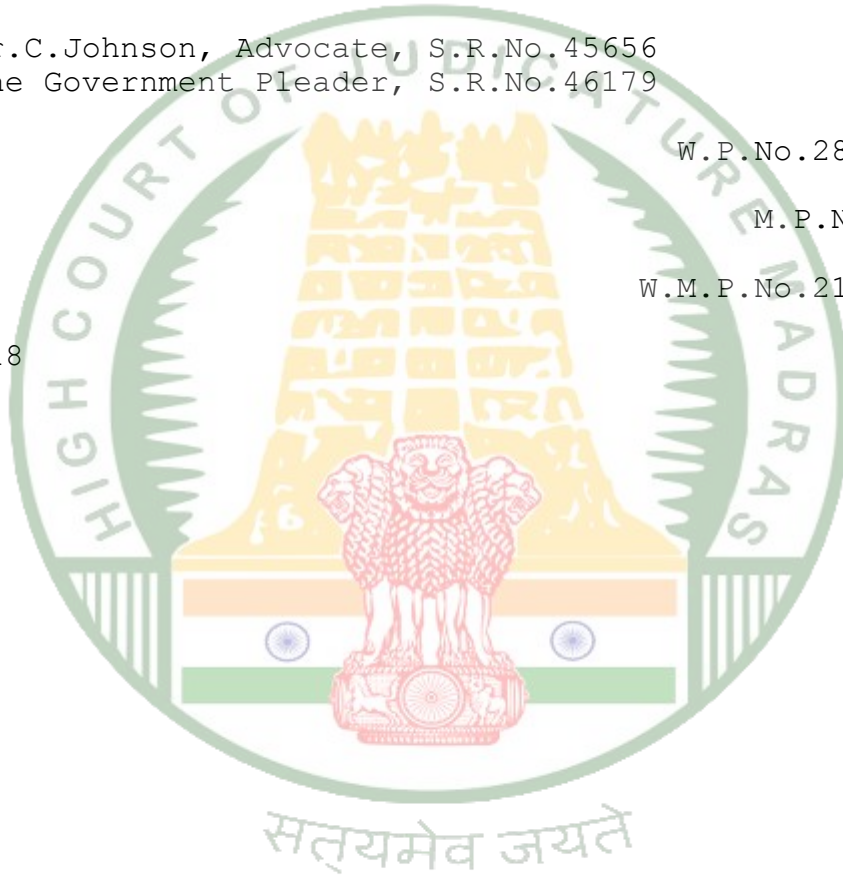
