This miscellaneous petition has been moved by the petitioner seeking extension of time to deposit the backwages as per the impugned order. Since a sum of Rs.25 lakhs is required to be deposited, due to financial limitations faced by the petitioner coupled with the brief holidays faced by the petitioner Management till January, 2018, they were not able to mobilize funds to make the deposit. Therefore, if time is extended by two more weeks, no

prejudice would be caused to anyone, it was pleaded.

2. Accepting the prayer, this Court grants finally two weeks time from the date of receipt of a copy of this order to make the deposit as per the impugned order. The miscellaneous petition is ordered accordingly.
