Nevertheless, whenever the bail application is being filed, it would be appropriate for the concerned Court to dispose of it as expeditiously as possible.

2. Hence, there shall be a direction to the learned Magistrate of the Juvenile Justice Board, Nagapattinam, to consider the petitioner's son's bail application in connection with Crime No.7 of 2018 and dispose of the same on its own merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

3. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.

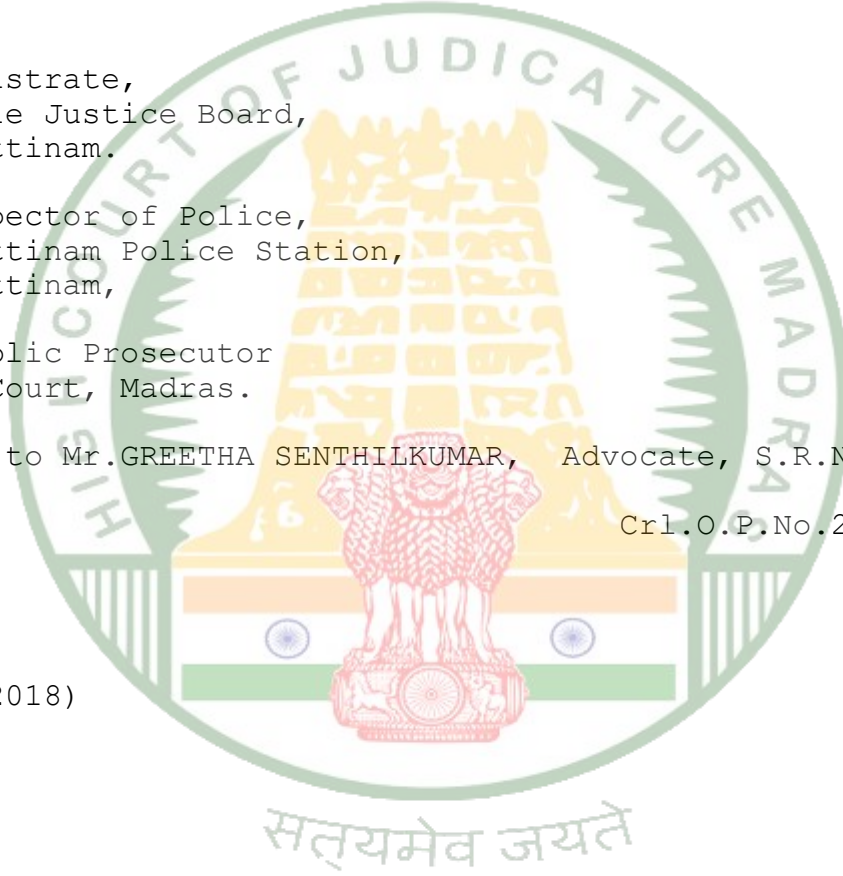
