ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent to complete the investigation and to file the final report in Crime No.11 of 2015, pending on the file of the respondent police.

2.By consent of both sides, this Criminal Original Petition is taken up for disposal.

3.Whenever any information in relation to commission of cognizable or non cognizable offence is received, the police officer shall adhere to the procedure contemplated under Sections 154 & 155 of the Criminal Procedure Code and after conducting necessary enquiry/investigation, file final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. Such investigation under Chapter XII of the Criminal Procedure Code shall be completed without any unnecessary delay. The delay in filing a final report in the present case is inordinate and unjustified. Hence, it would be appropriate to direct the Investigating Officer to file a final report within a stipulated time, if not already filed.

4.Considering the facts and circumstance of the case, this Court directs the respondent police to complete the investigation in Crime No.11 of 2015 pending on his file and file a final report within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of accordingly.

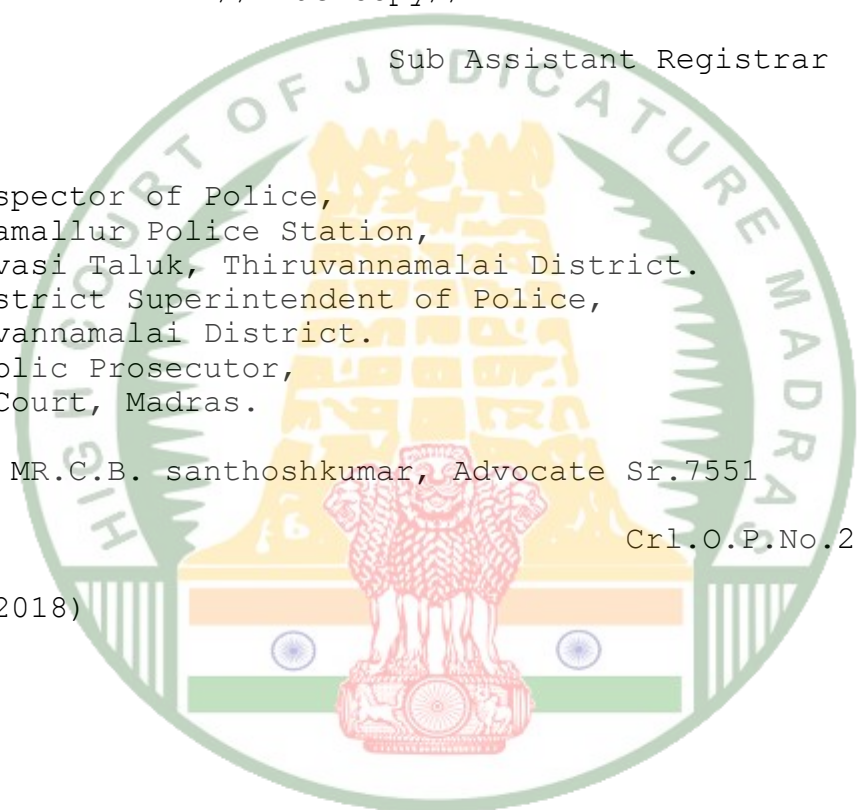

The seal of the High Court of Madras is a circular emblem. It features a central image of the Lion Capital of Ashoka, which is a four-lion capital carved from a single block of dark soapstone. The lions are facing the four corners of the capital. The capital is set on a base of four elephants, which are also facing the four corners. The entire emblem is surrounded by a green border. The words "HIGH COURT OF JUDICATURE MADRAS" are written in a circular path around the central image. At the bottom of the seal, the Sanskrit motto "सत्यमेव जयते" (Satyameva Jayate) is inscribed in Devanagari script.

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
