Prayer: Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records of the 1st respondent dated 17.03.2013 published by them in 'The Hindu' news paper in so far as it relates to the eligibility prescribed for DNS course leading to B.Sc., Nautical Science for 10 +2/equivalent candidates and quash the same and consequently direct the 1st and 2nd respondents to fix the eligibility for 10 +2/equivalent candidates for the DNS course leading to B.Sc., Nautical Science for the subsequent years on par with the Circular No.574/ECA1/2012, dated 30.04.2012 of the Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Tamil Nadu.
