This Appeal has been filed as against the order of dismissal of the divorce petition passed by the Principal Family Judge at Chennai.

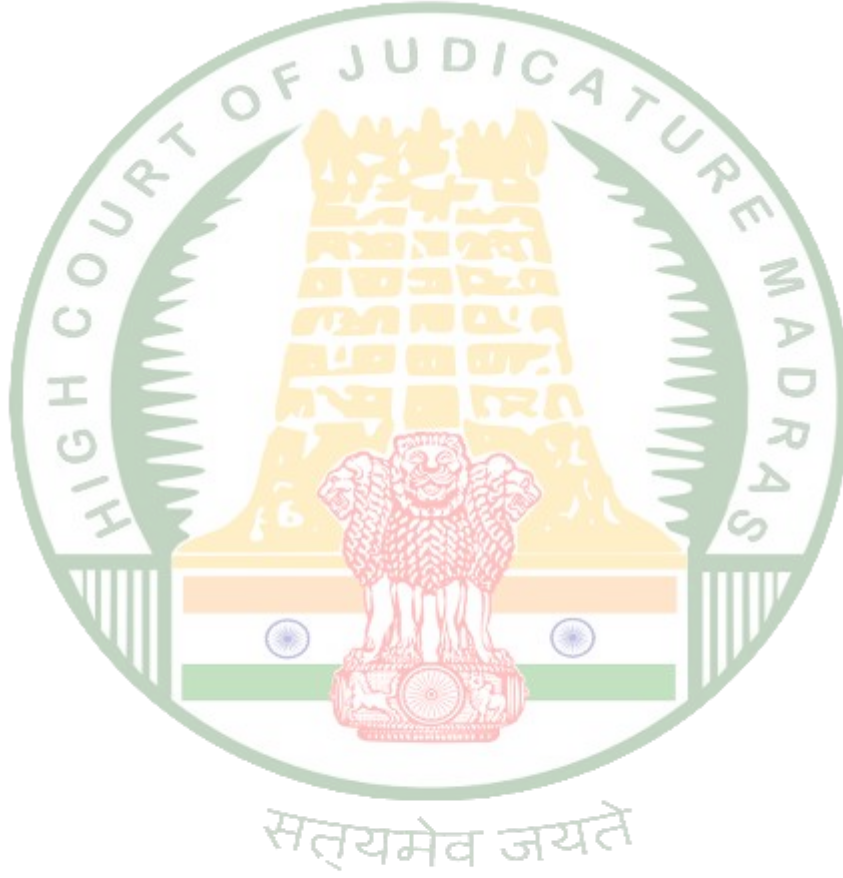
