The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that R.E.P. No.4 of 2015 has been dismissed for non prosecution. In view of the above

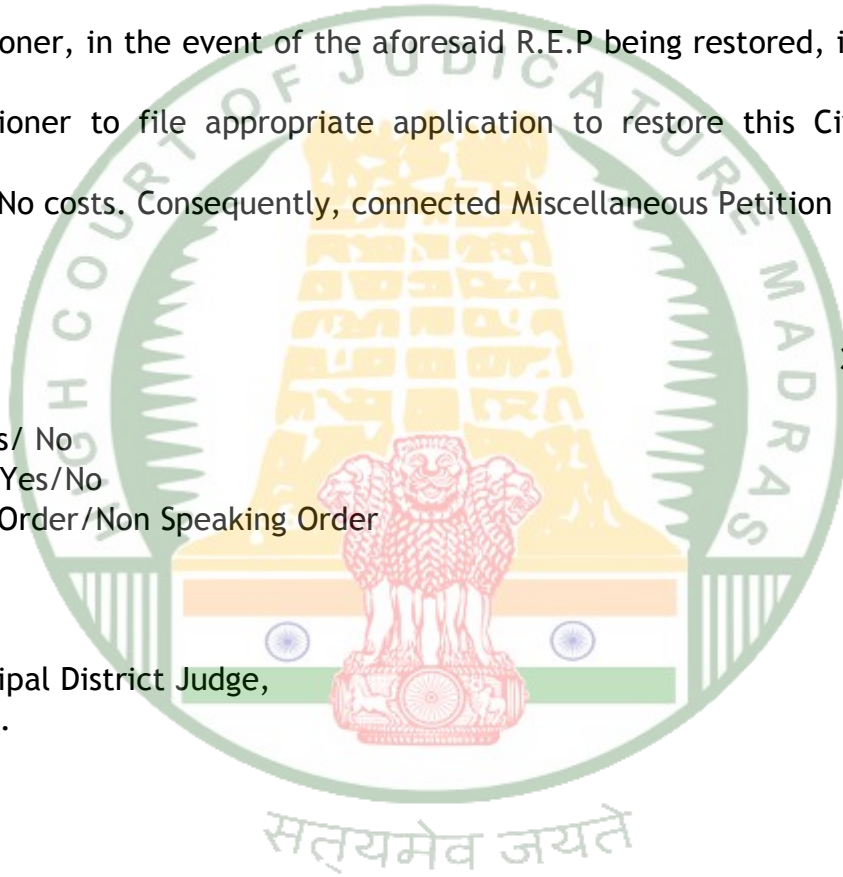
submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the Civil revision petition has become infructuous.
