ORDER

2.The petitioner has come up with this writ petition seeking a direction to the 3rd respondent to consider his representation dated 16.07.2018 and to issue appropriate direction to the fourth respondent to issue him patta within the time frame.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 16.07.2018 claiming the same relief as prayed in this writ petition, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4.Mr.V.Anandhamurthy, learned Standing Counsel taking notice for R1 and R2 and Mr.J.Ramesh, learned Additional Government Pleader taking notice for R3 and R4, submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court directs the 4th respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 16.07.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as any of the interested parties, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.

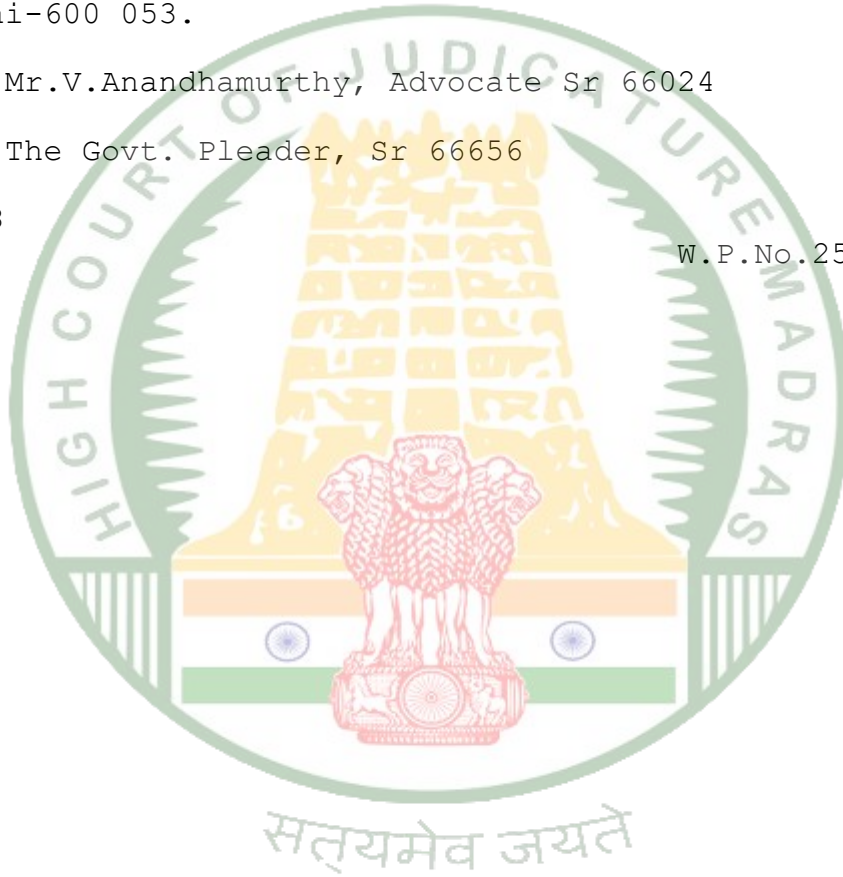
